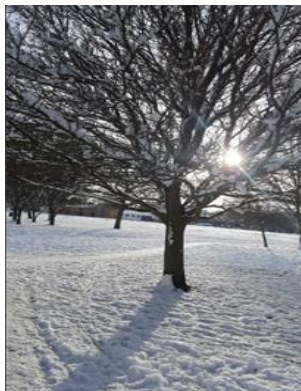


## Our New Home
